Body found in water off northeast Florida

JACKSONVILLE - A body believed to be that of a man who lost hold of his boogie board while in waters off the coast of northeast Florida has been found.

The St. Johns County Sheriff's Office says they found the body at about 11:15 a.m. Sunday. They believed it to be that of a man who went missing in the ocean a day earlier.

The victim is described as a 25-year-old man from Haiti.

A positive identification of the body and autopsy are planned.
